It has been one week since the Witherell Recreation Center, the CCBA Preschool, and the CCB all closed. With the COVID-19 situation unfolding rapidly, we wanted to take a minute to bring you up to speed on where things stand at the CCBA.

WHEN WILL WE REOPEN?

Social distancing requires us to remain closed for everyone's safety. We will not be opening on March 30th as we previously planned for the Witherell Recreation Center, or on April 6th as we had hoped for the CCBA Preschool. We will keep you posted about our reopening date as soon as we know it.

WE ARE HERE FOR OUR COMMUNITY

We continue to ask ourselves, "What can we do in the midst of this crisis?" We are a community center and we take care of our community as best we can. To that end, here are a few highlights of what's been happening:

- In consultation with the Board of Trustees, we paid all of our employees for the two weeks we announced we would be closed. Salaried staff continues working, mostly remotely.
- We have been calling all of our senior members to say hello and to make sure they have connections to community resources, should they need anything. If any member needs help now or in the future, please reply to this email and we will do our best to be of service.
- There is a severe shortage of available blood. We are partnering with the American Red Cross to hold blood drives in our game room area on two upcoming Wednesdays: 3/25 and 4/8. You can sign-up here. Please note that there are myriad health protocols in place when running the blood drives.
- We are sending hellos, exercises, and health and wellness tips viaour Facebook page. Join us virtually, if you can!
